We are a family owned RV park and we take pride in the cleanliness of our park. The rules are to ensure your experience and wellbeing. We hope you enjoy your stay!

Office

- Hours: 9:30 AM 6:00 PM Monday through Friday and 10:00-4:00 on Saturday.
- Check in is 2:00 PM (early check in fee is \$10) and check out is 12:00 noon. Late fees are applied to late check outs.
- After hour check ins and payments will be taken until 9:00pm.
- Ice, firewood, and quarters are available at the office.
- Mail can be received at the office.
- Staff is on site year round 24/7. In case of emergency, call 911.
- We do not offer weekly or monthly sites for pop up campers, truck campers
- Payment is due on the due date. Late fees may apply. To extend a reservation, office must be notified before 12:00 on departure date. Without notice, we cannot guarantee your site will be available.

Reservations

- Daily reservations require a deposit of one night, monthly reservations \$100 deposit
- Cancellation policy: 24 hour notice for a refund. *Subject to change during Crawfish Festival.
- No refunds for cancellations less than 24 hour notice, shortened visits, and/or due to acts of Nature.

RV's

- Must be in good condition and fully functional, approved at manager's discretion
- Rates are for an occupancy of 4 people
- Visitors are to register with the office. \$5 per person for overnight guests. Visitors' hours end at 11:00pm
- Washing of RV's is permitted with permission at a fee of \$5.00

Vehicles

- SPEED LIMIT IS 10 MPH.
- 2 vehicles and 1 RV per site. All adults must have a valid driver's license. Unauthorized vehicles may be towed at the vehicle owner's expense.

- Heavy equipment, ATV's, 3-wheelers, go carts, scooters, or mini bikes are prohibited.
- Golf carts must be operated by a licensed driver only.

Park Grounds

- **No littering.** A dumpster is provided at the entrance of the park. Please keep your site orderly. No clotheslines, appliances, or unsightly clutter.
- Parents are responsible for their children. Children must be supervised at all times. Bikes, skates, scooters are not allowed on the pavilion/bathhouse sidewalk; only on gravel road. Be careful and have fun.
- Quiet time is between 10:00 PM and 8:00 AM. Visitors must leave park by 11:00pm
- Do not tamper with electrical boxes. Campers are required to notify the office of any electrical problems.
- No smoking in any buildings. No firearms, BB guns, fireworks, or explosives allowed. No tents in RV spaces.
- Monthly campers are responsible for ant control at their site.

Fire Rings

• Fires are permitted in approved fire rings. Burn wood only, no cigarette butts or cans. Do not throw trash in the fire rings, please use the designated garbage cans. Fires should never be left unattended and must be extinguished before retiring for the night. Please minimize your campfire impact. Do not move rings from sites.

Pets

• Keep pets under control at all times. Dogs must be leashed. Owners are required to pick up unwanted 'surprises', even if no one is looking. Dog bags are available at the Pet Park, located behind the bathhouse. Do not leave pets outside unattended. Pets are not allowed in any buildings. We appreciate your courtesy.

We do not tolerate any unruly behavior for any reason. Any inappropriate conduct (including unnecessary disturbances and excessive noise) will result in a shortened stay without a refund. We reserve the right to refuse service.
